

## Financial Assistance

McKenzie Health is committed to ensuring our patients get the hospital care they need regardless of ability to pay for that care. Providing health care to those who cannot afford to pay is part of our mission and state law requires hospitals to provide free and discounted care to eligible patients. You may qualify for free or discounted care based on family size and income, even if you have health insurance.

If you think you may have trouble paying for your health care, please talk with us. When possible, we encourage you to ask for financial help before receiving medical treatment.

**What Is Covered?** For emergency and other appropriate hospital-based services at McKenzie Health, we provide free care, financial assistance, or charity care to eligible patients on a sliding fee scale.

**How to Apply: Any patient may apply for financial assistance/charity care by applying and providing supporting documentation.** If you have questions, need help, or would like to receive an application form or more information, please contact us:
